

# Witches' Walkway by FusionBeads.com



Approximate finished length: 8.25 inches

## **Beads and other products needed for one bracelet:**

- 56 - 5mm Jet Swarovski Elements Crystal Bicone Beads (05B11187)
- 29 - 5mm Tangerine Swarovski Elements Crystal Bicone Beads (05B11255)
- 54 - Size 8 Brass Plated Metal Round Seed Beads (SB1031)
- 1 - 10x14mm 2 Strand Gold Plated Magnetic Tube Bar Clasp (BM0393)
- 2 - 3mm Gold Plated Brass Round Crimp Beads (BM2536)
- 2 - 4mm Gold Plated Crimp Bead Covers (BM2345)
- 20 inches - Clear Soft Flex Wire .014 diameter (SM0310)
- 1 - Crystal Clear FireLine Braided Bead Thread .008 diameter, 6 lb/Size D (SM4429)

## **Tools needed to complete the bracelet:**

- Size 12 Pony Beading Needles (TL2382)
- Beading Scissors, 1 1/4 inch Blade (TL0302)
- Perfect End Thread Burner
- Crimping pliers (TL0500)

## **Beading Techniques needed to complete the bracelet:**

- Crimping
- Crimp Bead Covers
- Basic Right Angle Weave
- Using a Perfect End Thread Burner

## **Instructions to complete “Witches’ Walkway” bracelet:**

### **Step 1**

Weave a 2-row tall by 28-row long bracelet (see Basic Right Angle Weave Technique) using Jet and Tangerine crystal bicone beads in the pattern shown in the photo.

### **Step 2**

Reinforce the working thread and tail, and burn all thread ends with a Perfect End Thread Burner (see Using a Perfect End Thread Burner Technique).

### **Tip**

*In the following steps, beading wire will be crimped onto the clasp, and the woven beads alternating with seed beads will be strung onto the beading wire.*

### **Step 3**

Place one crimp bead and one loop on one side of the tube bar clasp onto a 10-inch length of beading wire. Pass the wire back through the crimp bead, and crimp the crimp bead (see Crimping Technique).

### **Step 4**

Cover the crimp bead with a crimp bead cover (see Crimp Bead Covers Technique), and trim excess wire with wire cutters.

### **Step 5**

String the first Jet crystal bicone bead in one long row of the bracelet onto the beading wire. String one seed bead, placing it in the space between the previously strung bicone bead and the one next to it.

### **Step 6**

In the same manner as in the previous step, continue stringing the Jet crystal bicone beads in the row while stringing seed beads between them.

### **Step 7**

String one crimp bead and the corresponding loop on the other side of the clasp onto the beading wire. Pass the wire back through the crimp bead, and crimp the crimp bead. Cover the crimp with a crimp bead cover, and trim excess wire with wire cutters.

### **Step 8**

Repeat Steps 3 – 7 with the remaining long row of woven beads and the remaining loops on the tube bar clasp.

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
